

Lockdown Procedures

As part of our duty to keep children safe, we have a plan for "lockdowns". Lockdown procedures are important and would be used in response to an internal or external incident which could be a threat to the safety of staff and children in the school.

Lockdown procedures may be activated in response to any number of situations, these may be:

- 1. A reported incident, disturbance in the local community
- 2. An intruder on the site
- 3. A warning being received regarding a local risk of air pollution (smoke plume, gas cloud etc)
- 4. A major fire in the vicinity of the school
- 5. The close proximity of a dangerous dog roaming close

In the event of an actual lockdown parents will be notified as soon as possible. Our lockdown procedure has restricted access. If you would like to see a copy please contact the school office.
