

Coronavirus (COVID-19) catch-up premium

This is a universal one-off grant of £80 per pupil in reception to year 11. It is allocated for the academic year 2020 to 2021 to all schools to help pupils make up for lost teaching time.



This statement sets out how Landkey Community Primary School intends to use its COVID-19 catch-up.

Intent: To enable children to fill gaps in their learning due to missed education through COVID-19.

Area of grant spend	Estimated cost	How the impact of the spend will be assessed
Reading – purchase of accelerated reader across school	£8251	Monitoring of programme – half termly assessments to track progress of pupils.
Maths and writing targeted intervention	£4,509	Teacher assessments in Spring and Summer terms to track progress and pupils selected accordingly. Pupil progress meetings – assess impact of intervention
Support for pupils’ social, emotional and mental health needs	£1,800	Pupils who are struggling to return to school will transition into school and be able to regulate and access learning. Children will be monitored during and after the intervention. SENCo to meet with class teachers to review impact of interventions
Remote learning Training of staff Allow access to IT infrastructure - devices	£1,200	Staff confident in delivery of home learning and the use of the home learning platform. All pupils able to access home learning and access live lessons and intervention
