REMOTE LEARNING

Dear Parents,

I expect you are still reeling in the shock of not having heard from me for a few days?! I hope you are all keeping safe and well.

Firstly, thank you for your support in the transition over to the Seesaw Platform. I imagine, by now, you are becoming more proficient and are getting used to using it. We, certainly, are finding it a far better platform to use and I am sure that the children could teach us all a few things about it.....why is it that they are so much better with technology than we are, they seem to instinctively just 'know'?! If you are struggling at all, or need support, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

In terms of Seesaw, a number of you have questioned as to whether whole families can remain logged in to the same device without needing to log back in and out all the time. Unfortunately, at this time, we are unable to access this part of the platform. However, we have managed to secure an individual QR code for each child in order to make logging in and out much easier if children share devices. The QR code will look similar to this:



If your child's device has a camera, then it is simply a matter of scanning the code using the camera each time they log in. If they do not have a camera, then they will need to input the code already supplied each time. QR codes have been printed and are available for collection from school. Some classes have already collected these along with maths workbooks, others will collect later in the week. A reminder of the collection times is as follows:

Year 2 and Year 6	Already collected both Maths Workbooks and QR codes
Year 1	Tuesday 19 th January pm
Year 4	Wednesday 20th January (this is an additional date to collect QR codes) am
Reception	Wednesday 20th January (this is an additional date to collect QR codes) pm
Year 5	Thursday 21 st January all day
Year 3	Friday 22 nd January all day

The books and codes will be left on the table, as previously, outside the main school entrance.



Devices and laptops are currently in the process of being distributed to children who are in need to support them with their learning. Once these have been allocated, there is a possibility that we may have additional devices available for loan. If you are struggling at home with the number of children requiring access to the same device, but did not qualify in the first instance, then please contact Emily Burns at eburns@landkey-primary.devon.sch.uk and we will do our very best to help.

Secondly, I have attached a 'Remote Learning' document outlining the provision and some frequently asked questions for your information. I hope this helps in clarifying the remote learning offer in school.
