Waste & Recycling Regulations

Since 1st April 2025, all schools in England must comply with the new waste and recycling regulations. By this date, recycling, and collection measures for all types of recyclable waste must be in place. Schools will be legally required to separate recyclable materials in accordance with the new regulations. Schools have to separate the following:-

Food waste

Glass (bottles, jars)

Metal (aluminium and steel tins, cans, foil)

Plastic (bottles, tubs, trays, containers)

Paper (envelopes, magazines, copier paper, shredded paper)

Cardboard (cardboard boxes, corrugated cardboard)

If schools don't comply with the new regulations they could be fined.

At lunch times, we will be asking children who have a packed lunch to put their rubbish back into their lunch boxes, to help with managing this process. We appreciate your ongoing support.


Year 6 – Leavers Hoodies

Now you might be asking what Railway 200 is, it's set to be a nation-wide celebration of the 200th anniversary of the birth of modern railways which originally began at the Stockton and Darlington Railway.
