When you access MCAS go to the Parents Evening tab on the left hand side of the screen and book your appointment.


Appointments will take place in your child's classroom and you should access the relevant room via the school playground.



Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal through the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme.

Eligible children in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) are also entitled to Free School Meals.

To find out if your child is eligible for Free School Meals apply through Devon County Council's <u>Citizens Portal</u>. If your application is successful, please send proof of eligibility to the school office (admin@landkey-primary.devon.sch.uk).

School Meals cost £2.50 per meal. Our preferred method of payment is via MCAS (the My Child At School Parent Portal). Meals must be paid for in advance or on the day the meal is taken. Please do not allow your child's dinner account to become overdrawn. We may ask you to provide packed lunch for your child whilst overdrawn accounts are cleared.
