We would like to make you aware that from September 2025, the price of school meals will increase to **£2.60** per meal.

This change reflects rising costs in ingredients, preparation, and delivery, while allowing us to continue providing high-quality, nutritious meals for all our pupils. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal through the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme.

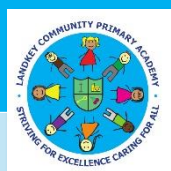
Eligible children in Key Stage 2 (Years 3 to 6) are also entitled to Free School Meals.

To find out if your child is eligible for Free School Meals apply through Devon County Council's [Citizens Portal](#). If your application is successful, please send proof of eligibility to the school office (admin@landkey-primary.devon.sch.uk).

School Meals cost £2.50 per meal. Our preferred method of payment is via MCAS (the My Child At School Parent Portal).

Meals must be paid for in advance or on the day the meal is taken. Please do not allow your child's dinner account to become overdrawn.

We may ask you to provide packed lunch for your child whilst overdrawn accounts are cleared.
