Communication and Language

We will be reading lots of different traditional stories. Asking and answering questions about the characters. We will be learning new vocabulary linked to our topics; castles and growing plants and using them in our talk. We will continue to learn new rhymes, poems and songs.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning about how to make healthy choices. Undertstanding that we need to have healthy bodies and minds to grow and develop. We will be taking steps in school to make our school days healthier. We will also be learning how to play turn taking games with our friends.

Physical Development

We will be developing our hand eye coordination through throwing and catching. We will be using a range of different sized balls and develop our accuracy. In class we will continue to develop our fine motor skills using a range of tools and equipment.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring the natural world around us, looking for and identifying plants and minibeasts in our surrounding environment. We will be growing plants and considering what these plants need to survive.

We will be finding out about castles and the people who live there. Learning new vocabulary and using it in our play.

Literacy

We will be continuing to use Read, Write Inc. to learn new sounds and blend sounds together to read words. We will be reading traditional tales, writing captions, sequencing stories and exploring repetitive phrases within texts. While learning about castles and plants we will be labelling, exploring diagrams and enjoying non-fiction texts.

Mathematics

We will be developing our number knowledge with a focus on 9 & 10. Representing these numbers in different ways. We will be naming and identifying 2D and 3D shapes. We will be noticing patterns in shape and number, making our own patterns and completing existing patterns.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring the art by Eric Carle, exploring with the techniques used to create his art as well as creating pieces inspired by his characters. We will be developing our drawing skills focusing on details and matching colours.
